Details and entry forms have been sent out to all Club Members who have provided emails. Others will receive theirs in the mail later. The AGM takes place first for members only, followed by a 2 course lunch and the Contest. The judge will remain secret until the day.

New this year we are going to have a Baby Puppy Walk for pups of 4-6 months at the start of the Contest. There is no need to enter the puppy, just turn up. There will be no awards, but the judge will go over the

puppies, so a wonderful chance for the puppies to have this experience before you consider maybe showing them and a good chance to socialise and see some beautiful Elkhounds.

WHO CAN COME? Anyone.

Even if you have not entered your dog or don't have a puppy, you can just come to watch and have lunch if you wish. You can also bring your dog. You will just need to fill out a Spectator Dog Slip. The 2 course lunch is £30 for Club Members and £35 for non members and needs to be booked and paid before January 27th.
